This is the extended version of the Jacoby Transfer after an opening of 1 No Trump by the responder to transfer to all four suits. The range of the No Trump opening becomes irrelevant as long as the partnership agreement raises or lowers the expected number of values to be held by the responder for game contracts. In all cases, for single-suited transfers, at least 6 cards in a minor is needed, and if the hand is not weak, denies a 4-card major.

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
